We are pleased to announce that as of December 23, 2011 the Kenora Catholic District School Board has now purchased the property that the Pinecrest skating rink sits on. This will provide the board with much needed space attached to our present Catholic campus in the east end of Kenora. Many thanks to our trustees and to Erica Bailey, Andrew Poirier, Gerard Dufresne, Will Ronnebeck and Andrew Koslowski for working so hard to make this purchase happen. We also want to thank all our neighbours and friends for their support.

The present plan for this property is to flood the ice when it gets cold enough so this ice surface is available to students and to the community in the evening. We will keep the principals up to date regarding a booking process shortly.

In the spring of 2012 the City of Kenora staff will demolish the present clubhouse. This structure is not safe and it will not be opened this winter. Right now it is being left there to protect the water source so we can flood the rink.

In the future we will be exploring some space for additional parking and a walking path through beside École Ste-Marguerite Bourgeoys. There are no plans at the present time to build anything on this property.
