## 300 Student Procedures

### AP 319: Enrolment – Children of Non-ratepayers

---

Concurring with the Ontario Ministry of Education’s philosophy of striving to provide equal educational opportunities for all children in our community, and consistent with the Kenora Catholic District School Board’s policy of providing a Christian learning environment, this Board will consider the enrolment of children from non-separate school ratepayers. St. Thomas Aquinas High School is an open access school that welcomes all families and students pending the following acceptability criteria.

#### 1. Process

- 1.1 The principal of the receiving school receives the application for new enrolments.
- 1.2 The principal determines if the new enrolment application meets the criteria for registration eligibility.
- 1.3 The parent/guardian must accept all of the board’s educational programs.
- 1.4 The Director of Education or Superintendent of Education will be consulted in any case where the principal has concerns regarding the eligibility of any student.

#### 2. Criteria for Registration Eligibility

- The current/projected enrolment
- The availability of appropriate educational programs
- The availability of special education services and programs
- Available facilities
- Available space
- Available transportation
