ART SUPPLIES

Visual Arts Classes

- Art journal (usually referred to as a drawing or sketch book, 9" x 12", 100 pages, 50-60 lb. paper)
- Regular writing pencils (**eraserless**)
- Fine black felt drawing pen (finer than a black marker)
- Eraser (**vinyl white only**) (**no pink pearl erasers**)
- 30 cm clear plastic ruler
- Pencil sharpener (one that holds the shavings)

- Pencil crayons (at least 12 colours, plus black and white) I recommend avoid budget pencils as they are not as effective and break easily when sharpened.

Please have supplies for first art class.

PLEASE NOTE

RE: LATEX ALLERGY

One of the teachers in the Grade 7 Wing has a severe latex allergy.

Examples of things that **cannot** be in the school are:

Basketballs
Elastic bands
Latex gloves
Balloons
Rubber bands
Pencils with erasers
Erasers (white vinyl erasers are okay) Hair elastics (covered are ok)
Rubber arm bracelets (Live Strong arm bracelets are okay because they are silicone)
