Supporting Your Catholic Schools Through Your Property Taxes

If you are a Catholic ratepayer we urge you to check your property tax bill to ensure that your support is directed to your local Catholic school board. You may not know this but by default your property taxes are automatically directed to the public school board unless you take the time to notify The Municipal Property Assessment Corporation that you want your taxes directed to the Catholic school board.

If you would like to change your property taxes from English-Public to English-Separate please follow these steps:

1. Identify your 19 digit roll number found on your Property Assessment Notice.
2. You will then need to complete a Request for Occupant Information Form found at www.mpac.ca. On the Request for Occupant Information Form there is a check box entitled School Board Support – you will need to select the English-Separate box to direct your property taxes to the Catholic school board.

By ensuring that you are accurately recorded as a Catholic school supporter you can help to deliver a powerful message to the government about the level of support for publicly funded Catholic education in Ontario. You will also be eligible to vote for your local Catholic school board trustees once you are registered as a separate school supporter.
