## OUTDOOR SNOW DAY ACTIVITIES

## **MATH CLASS!**

## **DISTANCE!**

If the snow is sticky consider a snowball throwing contest. The goal is for everyone to see how far they can get their snowball to go (challenge the children on how they are going to measure the distance). If the snow is not sticky, consider running and jumping as far as you can and see how far you get! This will also need to be measured.

## **ACCURACY!**

Consider playing snow-darts where a target is set up and different points are earned based on how close you get to the target. Perhaps hitting the target is worth 10 (or 2), the area close to the target is worth 5 (or 1) and everything else is worth 2 (or 0 -choose numbers based on your child's math level). This game can be as complicated or as simple as you want it to be! If your child is in grade 3, you might challenge them to multiply the numbers and if they are younger you might challenge them to add the numbers. You cannot go wrong when you are getting exercise outside, having a blast, and doing math!
