The Kenora Catholic District School Board is looking to enlist the support of an individual of First Nation ancestry to sit on the Board of Trustees for the Kenora District School Board. The Board provides directions and support to the following schools:

- Pope John Paul II (JK-6)
- St. John School, Ear Falls and Red Lake (JK-8)
- St. Louis School, Keewatin (JK-6)
- École Ste. Marguerite Bourgeoys (JK-6)
- St. Thomas Aquinas Secondary School (7-12)

A significant number of First Nation students attend these schools and are supported via Tuition Agreements or by taxation in the municipality. The Board of Trustees is comprised of 6 members who meet on a monthly basis and have a four-year term of office. There is also one Policy/Governance Committee meeting each month. Trustees are reimbursed for their travel expenses to attend a meeting. Trustees also receive an honorarium for this position.

## Trustees are responsible for:

- Establishing the system's mission and goals
- Approving curriculum guidelines for Catholic schools
- Establishing the annual budget
- Developing policies to ensure the efficient operation of the Board
- Determining the type, size and location of schools

## To be eligible to be the Native Trustee you must be:

- Catholic
- At least 18 years of age
- Entitled to vote in the area of jurisdiction of the Kenora Catholic District School Board
- A member of a Treaty #3 First Nation community
- Able to attend meetings on a regular basis (if you miss 3 meetings, you can be removed from the trustee position)
- Willing to distribute information to all First Nations stakeholders and

represent their interests at the Board level.
